

Winterizing Recommendations (if freezing temperatures are expected):

- If an equipment container is included, the interior temperature must be monitored and maintained above 32 degrees
- All external lines must be drained utilizing any available valves; if equipped with pneumatic fittings, remove any excess water in plumbing with the use of compressed air; it is also recommended to insulate all external plumbing when possible
- It is also recommended pouring colored -20 Degree windshield washer fluid in the float tank of the pressure washer and run the unit until it begins to come out of the wand. This will greatly reduce the chances of experiencing freeze damage to the pressure washer pump, coil or any other major components.
- **Note 1: these recommendations are suggestions to help minimize damage from freezing temperatures, but are not fail proof. It is the customer's responsibility to help prevent damage due to freezing.**
- **Note 2: the heater provided will supply a set amount of BTU's; any weather requiring more BTU's is the customer's responsibility**
- **Note 3: the Water Treatment System in the container must remain powered on to allow the water in the system to continue to circulate, as well as receive adequate oxygenation from the aerator**
